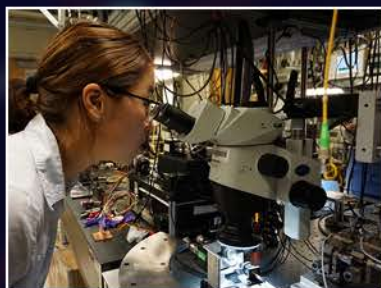


# UNDERGRADUATE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM SUMMER 2020

The Quantum Foundry undergraduate research internship program brings science and engineering California Community College (CCC) and California State University (CSU) undergraduate students to the UC Santa Barbara campus for an 8-week summer research experience. Undergraduate interns gain first-hand experience in scientific investigation via a dynamic, collaborative research environment.

## PROGRAM BENEFITS

## ELIGIBILITY

- Currently enrolled as an undergraduate student
- Over 18 years of age by the start of program and not enrolled in high school
- A US citizen or permanent resident
- Majoring or intends to major in science, engineering, or mathematics
- Has completed or currently enrolled in a minimum of 4 semester units of Calculus and completed a minimum of 12 semester units in science and/or engineering courses
